#### 4. Local Exchange Service

##### 4.1 Description

Local exchange service provides for a network access line and calling on a flat rate basis to exchanges within the flat rate local calling areas as follows:

Local Exchange Service is subject to all terms and conditions as outlined in this Tariff. Local Exchange Service can be activated by equipment generating pulses (rotary) or multi-tone (touch) signals to the switching equipment. The rates and charges for local exchange service are listed in Section 20.1. These rates and charges are for the period of one month, unless otherwise indicated, and entitle business subscribers to basic local exchange telephone service. Rates for business service are listed in Section 20.1

4. Local Exchange Service (Cont'd)

4.2 Taxes, Fees, and Charges

When any city, county or taxing authority imposes a franchise, occupation, business sales, license, excise, privilege, or similar tax of any kind on this Company, the amounts therein so far as practical, shall be charged on a pro-rata basis to all customers so affected receiving exchange service within the boundaries of that taxing entity. This tax charge, in all cases, will be in addition to the regular charges for local service and shall be set out as a separate item on the customer's bill.

4. Local Exchange Service (Cont'd)4.2 Taxes, Fees, and Charges (Cont'd)

Where a tax levied on a percentage of gross receipts, that percentage will be applied to each customer's bill so affected and the amount so computed will be added as a separate item to the customer's bill. Where a tax is levied other than on a percentage of gross receipts, a pro rata share of the total tax shall be added as a separate item to each customer's bill. All such taxes collected by the Company shall be paid to the city, county, or taxing authority in accordance with the promulgated regulations pertaining to each tax.

## 4.3 RESERVED FOR FUTURE USE.

4.4 Multi-Line Hunt ServiceA. Description

Multi-Line Hunt Service is available for Business Local Exchange Service where more than one line is in service. This service provides hunting over two or more lines in a designated hunt line group when the pilot number line is busy. Hunting is performed only when a pilot number of the hunt group has been dialed/keyed. Hunting for an idle number is performed in the same order each time based on one of the following options selected by the customer:

Sequential Hunt	Hunting starts with the line associated with the called directory number and ends when the call is completed to an idle line or when the last line of the hunt group is reached, whichever occurs first.
Circular Hunt	Hunting starts with the line associated with the dialed directory number of the hunt group and continues over all lines until the lines of the hunt group are searched once or the call is completed to an idle line, whichever occurs first.

4.4 Multi-Line Hunt Service (Cont'd)

A. Description (Cont'd)

**First Hunt**      Hunting starts with the first line in the hunt group regardless of the directory number dialed and continues to the end of the hunt group or until the call is completed to an idle line, whichever occurs first.

**Distributed Hunt**      Hunting commences at the line in the group which follows the last busy line in the hunt group until all lines are covered once or the call is completed to an idle line, whichever occurs first.

**Overflow Line**      When a call has reached the end of a hunt sequence without completing to an idle line, the call can receive one of the following treatments; the call may be routed to a busy tone, or, the call can be routed to a directory number outside the hunt group.

Customers may request that specific sequential numbers be reserved for use in conjunction with this service. Numbers may be reserved for future additional line requirements associated with this service. There will be a monthly charge as listed in Section 20.1(C) for each number so reserved.

B. Application of Rate

The Multi-Line Hunt Service rate is applicable to each line in the Multi-Line Hunt Service Group.

4.5 Special Arrangements

4.5.1 Promotional Offerings

From time to time, LightBound LLC. (LightBound) will introduce promotional offerings. LightBound may offer services at a reduced rate, or offer incentives including gift certificates and coupons for promotional, market research or rate experimentation purposes. Such offerings will be for a limited duration.

4.5.2 Contracts

LightBound may offer customized service packages on a case by case basis. Service offered under this schedule provision will be provided to customers pursuant to contract. Unless otherwise specified, the regulations for such arrangements are in addition to the applicable regulations and prices in other sections of this tariff.

4.5.3 Market Trials

LightBound may offer service to test and evaluate service capabilities, implementation procedures, technical processes, etc., for market research including rate experimentation purposes.
